

## **Dr. Robert Hayes**

Dr. Robert Hayes, a native of Saint John, is one of only 14 practising dermatologists in Canada to have completed a specialized Fellowship in Mohs Micrographic Surgery.

Dr. Hayes grew up in Blacks Harbour and Saint John and completed some of his medical training in the city. He graduated from the University of New Brunswick in 1996. He finished medical school at Dalhousie University in 2000 and a dermatology residency at the University of Toronto in 2005. He completed his Mohs Micrographic Surgery fellowship at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver in 2006.

He says that he made a commitment to come back to Saint John when he was a resident here and indicates that “the medical community in Saint John is very supportive. I have been working closely with the local group of plastic surgeons and Department of Laboratory Medicine to get this clinic underway.” Specifically, Dr. Hayes has been in close contact with [Dr. James O'Brien](#), Dr. John Dornan, and Dr. Anne O'Brien. Dr. Doug Keeling and Dr. Kathy Baxter, both dermatologists who work in Saint John, have also been very supportive.
